Beckum, 9 December 2025 – Today BEUMER Group celebrates its 90th anniversary, reflecting on another record-breaking year. With an order intake of 1.39 billion euros and 5,700 employees worldwide, the intralogistics specialist achieved its best ever results in 2024. This achievement is the culmination of the company's long-term independent strategy, which, as a family business, priorities foresight over short term market trends.

How can a company succeed on a global scale, even in challenging times? For BEUMER Group, the answer lies in a value-driven strategy. Rather than pursuing short-term profit maximisation, the intralogistics specialist is committed to sustainable growth. This is based on quality leadership, innovation and a strong international presence. The company's motto "Made Different" represents an independent approach. BEUMER Group focuses on stability, reliability and collaborative partnerships, setting itself apart from current mainstream trends.

"Reliable", "down-to-earth", "ambitious" and "collaborative" – these four values shape the company culture and form the foundation for stable customer relationships and high employee retention. This ethos is evident in the company's business performance: in addition to a record order intake of 1.39 billion euros, global revenue increased to 1.23 billion euros in 2024



(compared to 1.15 billion euros the previous year). The BEUMER Group expects a further significant increase in order intake for the 2025 financial year.

Innovation as a growth driver and differentiator

Innovation is a key driver of BEUMER Group's success. The company strategically invests in new technologies, digital business models, and the continuous development of its portfolio. A recent example of this is the integration of the companies Codept and Elara. Both emerged from BEUMER's company builder, BEAM, and today strengthen the group's digital offerings. In parallel, BG.evolution in Dortmund, Germany, is developing digital solutions to complement the existing product and system portfolio. The team works in the innovative environment of Digital Hub Logistics, maintaining close relationships with universities and research institutions. BEUMER's internal Innovation & Development department also supports portfolio development, aiming to deliver at least one forward-looking innovation per year. Through data-driven solutions, flexible production networks and robust customer support, BEUMER establishes itself as a leader in quality and technology in intralogistics. In this context, the ability to adapt flexibly to changing customer needs is just as important as sustainability and excellent employee development.

Carried by tradition, shaped by pioneering spirit and globalisation

Globalisation is another important factor in the company's success and helps it to remain resilient in a volatile global economy. Since its foundation in 1935, BEUMER Group has evolved from a local machine factory in Beckum to become a leading global provider of intralogistics systems, with around 40 companies operating worldwide. Key milestones include international expansion in the 1960s, pioneering technological advances in overland conveyors and sorting systems, and successfully integrating and developing acquired companies such as Crisplant in Denmark, Enexco in India or FAM in Magdeburg. By digitally transforming its portfolio, BEUMER successfully combines proven tradition with forward-looking progress, always with the goal of offering genuine added value to customers.

"Nine decades of BEUMER Group demonstrate a willingness to repeatedly break new ground and seize opportunities courageously," says Dr. Christoph Beumer, BEUMER Group's Chairman of the Advisory Board. 1. Organisation and Key Figures

BEUMER Group is an independent third-generation family-owned business that ranks among the world's leading providers of material handling solutions. With around 40 companies and over 5,700 employees worldwide, the group achieved an order intake of 1.39 billion euros and a revenue of 1.23 billion euros in the 2024 financial year.

The organisation is structured into five Centres of Competence (CoC): Airport, Logistic Systems, Minerals & Mining, Product Business and Customer Support. The portfolio ranges from high-performance sorting systems, conveying and packaging technology to digital solutions for various industries, including chemicals, mining and cement, consumer goods, ecommerce, airports, and courier, express and parcel (CEP) services. The company's motto "Made Different" encapsulates the philosophy of sustainable success, innovation and a robust global presence.

2. Family Business, Values and Culture

As a family business, BEUMER Group places particular emphasis on reliability and a long-term perspective. Being independent of external investors enables the company to make strategic decisions with foresight. BEUMER Group has remained consistently true to its own mission statement over the decades: "We want long-term success, not short-term profit." Even with the appointment of Rudolf Hausladen as Chairman of the Executive Board in 2022, the connection to the founding family's roots and corporate culture remains intact. Hausladen emphasises: "I intend to continue leading the company in the same tradition and spirit as the BEUMER family." This combination of family tradition and fresh external perspectives strengthens the group's future position.



The guiding principles for action are described in the lived corporate culture "Made Different", which is also set to be the key to future success. It embodies the ambition to do things differently and better, while preserving what is good and building on what has been proven. The BEUMER culture is shaped by the following four values: "reliable", "down-to-earth", "ambitious" and "collaborative". These values establish a sense of unity across all locations and also serve as a guiding framework during turbulent times. The customer is always at the centre. Long-term, collaborative partnerships and a deep understanding of clients' needs are firmly anchored in the corporate culture.

One example of "Made Different" in practice is BEUMER Group's proactive customer support. With 24/7 availability, predictive maintenance and tailored service offerings, the company supports its customers throughout the entire lifecycle of their systems – setting standards for long-term, collaborative partnerships in the industry.

3. Looking Back: From Local Family Business to Global Player

Founding Years - Pioneering Spirit in Beckum

On 9 December 1935, the 33-year-old senior engineer Bernhard Beumer started his first day of work as his own boss – with just four employees and a small, vacant factory hall. The young engineer brought courage, determination and, above all, extensive expertise in conveying technology. He had previously worked as a repair fitter in the Ruhr region's mining industry, before completing his engineering degree and gaining initial experience at a conveyor system manufacturer in Essen. He was soon able to secure his first orders from the building materials, cement and mining industries.

An important technological milestone was reached with the development of a carrying roller with labyrinth sealing. This was patented and still serves as the basis for the company logo used today. The circle in the logo represents the cross-section of the carrying roller tube, while the arrow represents the axle and direction of rotation. Quality and an inventive spirit have paid off. Even before the outbreak of the Second World War, BEUMER had around 100 employees.



Second Generation: Internationalisation and Diversification

After decades of continuous growth, Bernhard Beumer Senior handed over management of the company to his eldest son, Dipl.-Ing. Bernhard Beumer. Having worked alongside his father for 18 years, he took over the business following his father's death in 1981. Under the leadership of the second generation, which also included the two brothers Peter and Ludwig, BEUMER evolved from a local conveyor system manufacturer into an increasingly international company. Technologically, the company remained a pioneer. In the 1960s, BEUMER laid the foundations for curved belt conveyors, enabling projects such as a 12.5-km-long limestone conveyor in China 50 years later.

At the same time, Dipl.-Ing. Bernhard Beumer set decisive strategic directions for diversification and global expansion. Early on, he specialised the product portfolio in three core areas: Conveying & Loading, Palletising & Packaging, Sorting & Distribution. He also established the first international subsidiaries, including those in Brazil, the USA, and Thailand.

Third Generation: Globalisation through Growth and Acquisitions

The turn of the new millennium saw the third generation take the helm. Since 2000, Dr Christoph Beumer, the founder's grandson, has led the family business as CEO. Under his leadership, the company has developed into a group that operates globally through organic growth and selected acquisitions.

In 2009, Crisplant, a Danish sorting system specialist, and in 2011, Enexco, an Indian cement packaging system manufacturer, were integrated into the group. This made BEUMER the world market leader in airport baggage handling and CEP sorting systems, whilst strengthening its position in the Indian cement market. In 2022, BEUMER acquired FAM GmbH, a Magdeburg-based provider of bulk material and loading technology, thereby strengthening its international mining sector portfolio.

4. Innovation and Digitalisation

Innovation has always been a key driver of BEUMER Group's success. The company has a clear strategy: innovations should not emerge by chance but be systematically developed and brought to market maturity. Since 2018, the group's own company builder, Beam, has been



developing digital business models. Recent examples include the start-ups Codept and Elara, which today strengthen the group's digital offerings.

The Innovation & Development department is responsible for driving forward new solutions internally, from the initial idea through evaluation to market launch. The goal is to realise at least one market-ready innovation each year. Furthermore, the additional innovation unit BG.evolution, based in Dortmund, develops digital solutions to complement the existing product and system portfolio.

These innovation efforts aim to combine traditional engineering excellence with modern technologies to offer customers comprehensive systems from a single source. The motto "Made Different" represents not only technological differentiation, but also a lived innovation culture that creates genuine customer value – through efficiency, transparency and future viability.

5. Outlook

The anniversary "90 Years of BEUMER – 90 Years of 'Made Different'" captures the values the group stands for today: pioneering spirit, down-to-earth, enthusiasm for innovation, focus on the long-term, and a dedication to quality and collaborative responsibility. BEUMER Group is staying true to this commitment for the future.

The family business's journey is far from over – on the contrary, the executive management is working closely with the owner family to actively shape the company's future direction. The current strategy, which extends to 2028, is already generating new momentum to ensure the company stays on course in highly volatile times. The overarching goal is to establish BEUMER as the "Partner of Choice" – the preferred partner – for customers worldwide. This will be achieved by offering genuine differentiation in terms of quality, service, innovation and sustainability, by collaborating even more closely with clients and partners.

The corporate strategy aims to secure sustainable growth, drive innovations forward systematically and further expand digitalisation. The focus is always on customer needs and collaborative partnerships with employees, partners and the public. With its strong values, a



clear vision and the courage to break new ground, BEUMER Group intends to continue setting the standard in intralogistics in the decades to come.


